

Pairing the Palm Bluetooth Card with an Ericsson T39m or Ericsson R520m?




In order to use your Palm Bluetooth Card with your Ericsson T39m, you need to pair the two devices.

Install onto your Palm handheld the Bluetooth and Phone services from the CD-ROM included with your Palm Bluetooth Card. Insert the Palm Bluetooth Card in the expansion slot.

Activate the Bluetooth function on your T39m:
 Scroll to *Extras, YES, Bluetooth, YES, Operation Mode, YES, On, YES*

Follow the steps below :

<p>1- In the launcher, Tap on Prefs 2- Choose Bluetooth 3- Make sure that Bluetooth is Enabled</p>  <p>4- Tap the Trusted Devices button</p>	<p>5- Make the T39 discoverable : Scroll to <i>Extras, YES, Bluetooth, YES, Discoverable , YES</i> 6- Make the T39 accept the pairing with a device Scroll to <i>Extras, YES, Bluetooth, YES, Paired devices, YES, Add device ?, YES, Phone accepts, YES</i></p>

7- Tap Add Device

8- The Palm is searching for Bluetooth devices and the T39 should be listed in the discovery

9- Select the T39

10- Tap OK

11- T39 displays : Add Palm to paired devices, YES

12- Enter the passkey, YES

13- Enter the same passkey and Tap OK

14- Make sure the T39 is now added in the list of Trusted devices

Pairing the Palm Bluetooth Card with an Ericsson T68?



In order to use your Palm Bluetooth Card with your Ericsson T68, you need to pair the two devices..

Install onto your Palm handheld the Bluetooth and Phone services from the CD-ROM included with your Palm Bluetooth Card. Insert the Palm Bluetooth Card in the expansion slot.

Activate the Bluetooth function on your T68:

Scroll to *Connect, YES, Bluetooth, YES, Operation Mode, YES, On, YES*

Follow the steps below :

Pairing the Palm Bluetooth Card with a Nokia 6210 + connectivity pack DTL-1P,



Replace the standard battery at the back of your phone by the Bluetooth Connectivity Battery. Switch on the phone. An icon showing a dot with waves radiating from it ((•)) should be displayed at the upper left corner of the screen. This means that the Nokia 6210 has the correct version of software.

The software revision should be V05.02 or higher. To check the firmware on a Nokia phone, type in the following command: `*#0000#`.

Please check with your local Nokia phone dealer to get a free upgrade.

On the Nokia 6210, there is no user interface to set up Bluetooth. The Bluetooth passkey required for the pairing is hard-coded. It is printed in 2 different places:

- When you open your connectivity pack, you will find the battery protected in a plastic sleeve. There should be a printed label on the plastic sleeve with the serial number and the Bluetooth passkey

- If you don't have this plastic sleeve, follow the steps below
 - o Remove the connectivity battery



- Unclip the hatch at the back of your connectivity battery



- Remove the white Li-Ion battery



- You'll discover a printed label with the serial number and the Bluetooth passkey at the back of the slot which contains the battery. The passkey is written below the second bar code.

Once you have the Bluetooth passkey, follow the steps below:

Palm OS 4.x	Nokia 6210 + connectivity pack
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- In the launcher, Tap on Prefs 2- Choose Bluetooth 3- Make sure that Bluetooth is on 4- Tap the Trusted Devices button 5- Tap Add Device 6- The Palm is searching for Bluetooth devices and the Nokia 6210 should be listed in the discovery Results window 7- Select the Nokia 6210 8- Tap OK 9- Enter the passkey found under the hatch of your Bluetooth Connectivity Battery 10- Tap OK 11- Make sure the Nokia 6210 is now added in the list of Trusted devices
